## President Trump says he'll keep funding Planned Parenthood... if abortion goes

President Donald Trump and the American government have proposed a potential deal in which Planned Parenthood would still receive federal funding - but on one rather mammoth condition: they no longer perform abortions.

Speaking to *The New York Times* yesterday, Trump stated the following: "I am pro-life and I am deeply committed to investing in women's health and plan to significantly increase federal funding in support of nonabortion services such as cancer screenings... There is an opportunity for organizations to continue the important work they do in support of women's health, while not providing abortion services."

As a staunchly pro-life President, many have expected Trump to work towards banning abortion altogether. He has expressed his desires to take America back to before the landmark 1970s Roe v Wade decision - which legalised abortion - meaning it return to a state-by-state decision. Indeed, [Republican house speaker Paul Ryan revealed he wants to defund Planned Parenthood entirely earlier this year.](#)

Planned Parenthood is seen as a crucial organisation for women, not only due to its abortion services, but also because it provides important news and resources on sexual and reproductive health including contraception. It therefore comes as little surprise that Planned Parenthood has hit back at the Republican government, stating they would not accept a deal where they had to stop performing abortions.

"Let's be clear: Federal funds already do not pay for abortions," said Dawn Laguens, the executive vice president of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America.

She continued: "Offering money to Planned Parenthood to abandon our patients and our values is not a deal that we will ever accept. Providing critical health care services for millions of American women is nonnegotiable."

Planned Parenthood currently receives about \$500 million annually in federal funding, meaning if their funding was cut, they would seriously suffer.

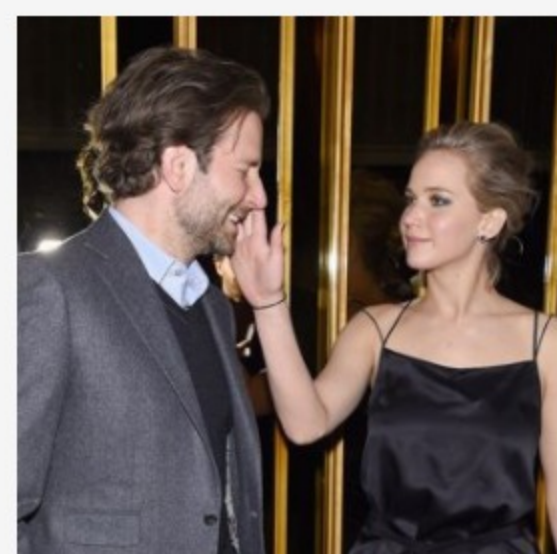
